Visit These Exciting Ports of Call

Shanghai, China, January 23

Shanghai is one of the most modern and beautiful cities in the world. The number of skyscrapers and other ultra modern buildings built during the last decade is almost unbelievable. In addition, many of the interesting old sections remain, so the optional pre-cruise visit is warranted and recommended.

Okinawa, Japan, January 25

Much history from the fierce battles of World War II remains in Okinawa. Be sure to visit Shuri-jo Castle while there and shop the colorful mix of Japanese department stores and traditional shops on Kokusai Streets.

Taipei, Taiwan, January 27

Taipei is the largest city in Taiwan and has served as the de facto capital. It is a bustling city with numerous attractions. The National Museum contains the world's largest collection of Chinese Art and is worth a visit. A popular tourist site is the National Taiwan Democracy Memorial Hall.

Hong Kong, China, January 29 and 30

There are two full days in Hong Kong, one of the most interesting and exciting cities in the world. Take a Harbor cruise and enjoy the fantastic view from Victoria Peak. Perhaps best of all, "shop until you drop".

Da Nang/Hue, Vietnam, February 1

Da Nang, the third largest city in Vietnam, will bring back many memories to veterans of the Vietnam war. Ringed by mountains on one side and the East Sea on the other, Da Nang has many sites of historical interest and natural beauty.

Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon), Vietnam, February 3

Saigon is the largest city in Vietnam and is still adorned with wide boulevards and historic French colonial buildings. Be sure to see the Reunification Palace and visit the War Remnants Museum.

Singapore, February 5

Singapore is an island city-state located at the southern tip of the Malay Peninsula. It is the smallest nation in Southeast Asia but is substantially larger than the other two surviving city-states, Monaco and Vatican City. It is a modern, clean and beautiful city with excellent shopping available.

Ko Samui, Thailand, February 7

It is Thailand's third largest island and is a resort rich with natural resources, white sandy beaches, coral reefs and coconut trees. Since the early 1990's, the island has soared in popularity. It is an oasis of natural beauty.

Bangkok, Thailand, February 8

Bangkok has a wealth of cultural landmarks and attractions. The Grand Palace and the Palace complex and its thousands of temples make Bangkok one of the most unusual and scenic cities in the world. A post-cruise extension is highly recommended.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

Reservations: A deposit of 20% of the cruise fare per person is required to secure space on the cruise. Balance is due at least 75 days prior to departure.

Cancellations and Refunds: All payments are fully refundable until 75 days prior to departure. From 74 to 57 days there is a cancellation fee of the amount of the deposit. 56 to 29 days prior to sailing date, 50% of the total costs will be charged. 28 to 15 days prior to sailing date, 75% of fare per person will be charged. Within 14 days of sailing, penalty is 100% of total charges per person.

Fuel Supplement: A fuel supplement may be imposed on all passengers and is subject to change. At the time of printing, no fuel supplement is in effect. However, Princess expects to impose a fuel supplement of up to \$9 per person per day if the NYMEX of price exceeds \$70 per barrel.

Shipboard Gratuities: To save you the worry of who to tip and how much, Princess makes it easier for you to reward excellent service by automatically adding a discretionary hotel and dining charge of \$11 for suites and mini-suites, and \$10.50 for all other staterooms per passenger per day.
